The new Funding & Tenders Portal

- Replaces the Participant Portal
- Will become the **unique entry point** for fully electronic management of centrally managed **grants** and **procurement contracts**
- As a **corporate platform** for electronic data exchange, it delivers on the **Single Electronic Data Interchange Area (SEDIA)** as stipulated in the EU financial regulation.
- **Ensure a strong alignment to the corporate, EU visual identity: new look & name** were agreed on a **corporate level** in close cooperation **with DG COMM and DG BUDG.**
- (Abbreviation: **F&T Portal**)

- **Public Launch on 27 September 2018**
- Beta release end of June 2018
- Testing phase (July- Sept.)

Funding & Tenders Portal

Testing phase outcomes

- Testing Phase: **July–September 2018**
- More than **800 users** invited to test the new portal:
 - Internal call coordinators and PP users (+/- 200)
 - External Legal Entity Appointed Representatives (LEARS) & Account Administrators (+/- 540)
 - External volunteer testers (+/- 70)
- Number of **feedback received**: +/- 600

Funding & Tenders Portal *Testing phase outcome*

- Type of feedback received:
 - Very positive comments
 - No major critical issues/bugs encountered
- Main improvements concerns:
 - Graphic/design
 - H2020 filter by programme part
 - Sorting in My Proposals/Projects
 - Call page/topic page
- Frequent releases of improved beta versions between July and September, implementing suggested changes

- End of September: - Public release > **Pop-up** inviting PP users to go to the new Portal.
- End of November : - **Automatic redirection** from old PP to the F&T Portal. (Link back to the old PP available just in case= **no longer available**).

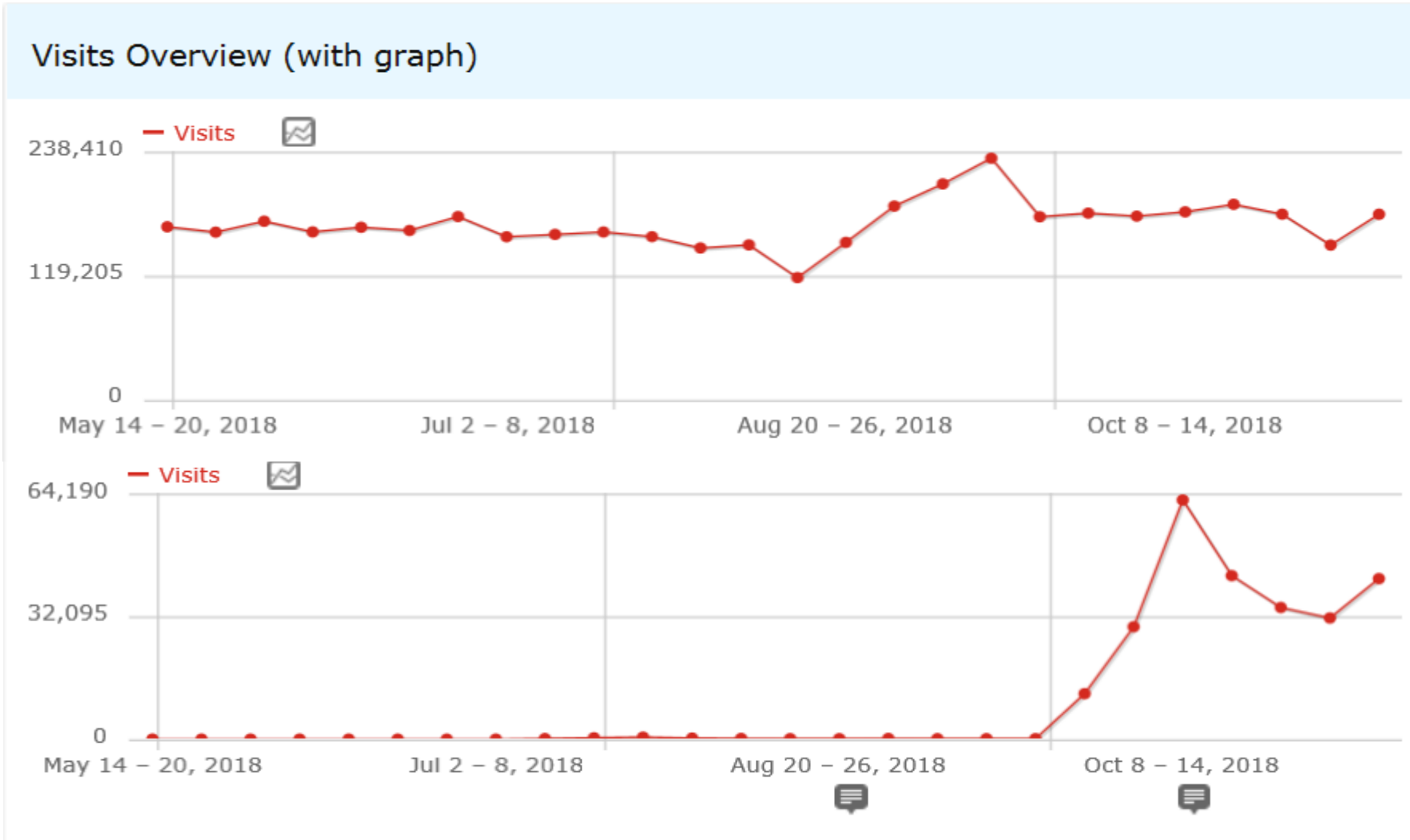

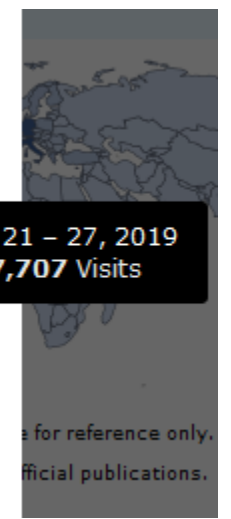

Statistics: PP (top) & F&T Portal (bottom) visits weekly (Jan. 2019)



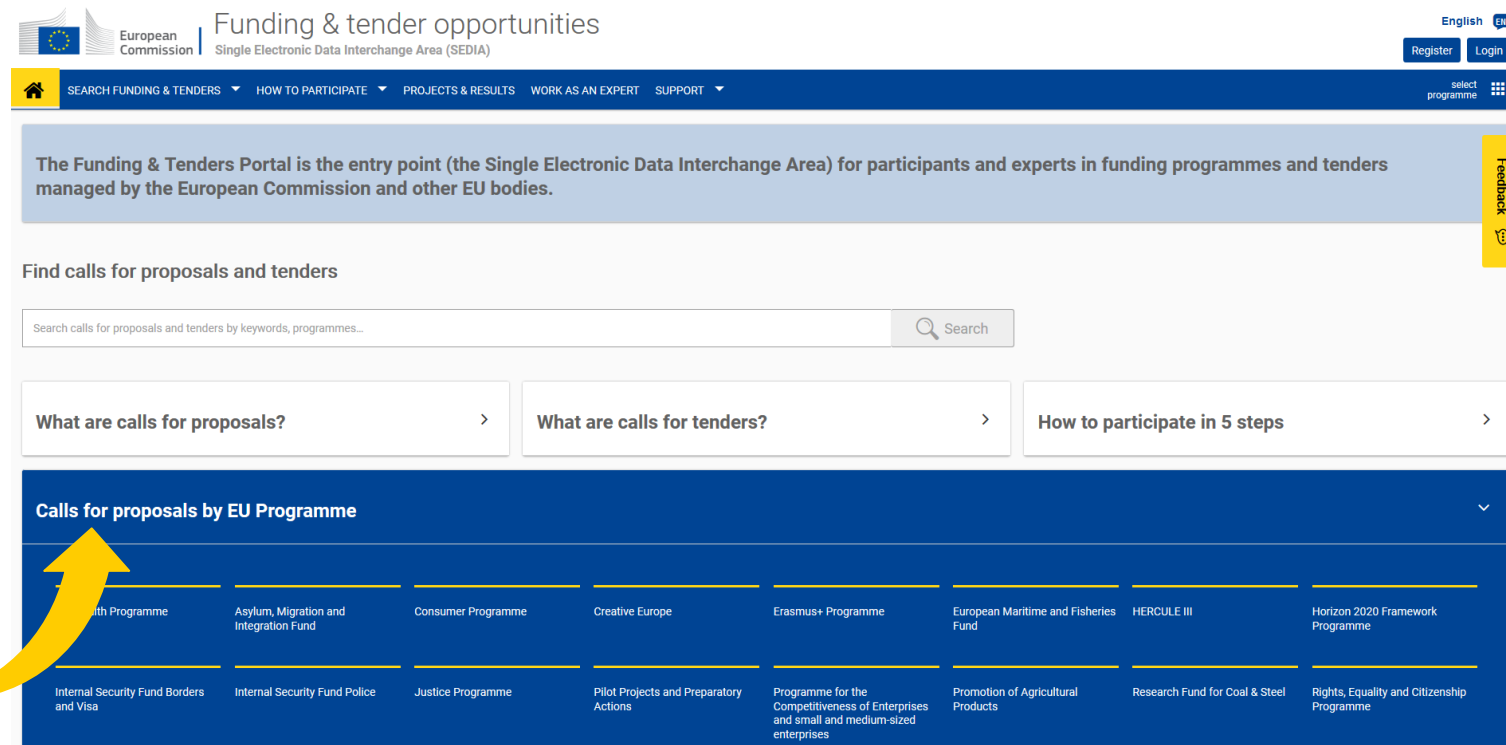

- It allows searching for **EU funding** and **tender opportunities**, and **managing grants** and **contracts** in **one place**.




Main features

Specific Challenge:

Citizen science is blooming across all scientific disciplines and the humanities. It can potentially bring a wide variety of benefits to researchers, citizens, policy makers and society across the research and innovation cycle, e.g. it can accelerate and sometimes even make possible the production of new scientific knowledge; it can help policy makers monitor implementation and compliance with regulations; it can increase public awareness about science and feeling of ownership of policies; and it can enable faster and evidence-informed reactions to events and better territorial coverage.

At the same time there are difficulties setting up citizen science initiatives – in terms of choosing the optimum methodologies; in terms of quality assurance and validation of the outcomes; in terms of linking the various governance levels, from local to global; in terms of ensuring balanced participation of citizens (e.g. regardless of background, gender and age); in terms of integrity of methods and data; in terms of recognising the work of citizens participating in citizen science initiatives; in terms of managing large numbers of volunteers for many months or even years (and

3. Search by Programme

Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund



For the years 2014-20, the overall Home Affairs budget amounts to EUR 10.52 billion. The largest part of these resources consists of two big Home Affairs Funds and the remainder (EUR 2.36 billion) is reserved for the funding of the Home Affairs Agencies.

With an overall budget of EUR 6.9 billion, the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund and the Internal Security Fund will finance actions supporting EU Home Affairs policies in the period 2014-20 and through these actions build a more open and secure Europe.

In the implementation of the actions in the fields of asylum, migration and integration and internal security and borders supported by these two Funds, the Commission will work closely together with EU States. For actions carried out at EU level, the Commission will also directly cooperate with international and civil society organisations via grants and public contracts that are awarded through calls for proposals and procurement procedures respectively. At times, also calls for experts are organised to provide opinions and advice on specific topics.



Security: 2-step verification



- Increase the security by opting for 2-step verification: to access the MY AREA, you will then have to **login with something you know** (your password) and **something you own** (e.g. mobile phone or device).

You will have to register your mobile phone or device as a second authentication factor before you can activate the 2-step verification for your account.



New features

- **New roles linked to Audits**
- **New section 'My audit ' available under My Area** (to be used by external auditors).
- **Expert profile delegation under "My expert Area"**

Experts will be now able to:

- **delegate** the administration of their expert profile
- **manage their delegations** via the F&T Portal

New roles linked to Audits

- The following **new roles** linked to **Audits** have been implemented:
 - **grant audit contact role** in an organisation
 - **access an audit project** with "**audit contact**" role
 - **access an audited project** with "**external audit**" role

My Audit

New section available under My Area

- A new section is now available under **My Area**, called **My Audits** to be used by **external auditors**.
- An **external auditor** can:
 - launch, via **My Audits**, the corresponding audit process in PPAMS for the organisations to be audited in the given projects
 - nominate other External Auditor(s)
 - Revoke other External Auditor(s)
 - Read all data and artefacts of the audited projects
- The **audited firms** access their tasks via **My Organisations** and the Audit Management (AM) button.

What has not been changed yet?

- IT tools that are accessible from the Portal will follow the visual changes according to their priorities.
- After entering My Projects – Manage Project, the grant management system, PPGMS looks the same.
- New programmes are coming on board – there will be **continuous changes...**

- Update guidance documents regarding the name of the new Portal.
